Wisconsin Veterans Bill of Rights

- To ensure that veterans are treated with courtesy and respect at all Wisconsin Job Center offices.
- To give priority in referral to jobs to qualified veterans and eligible persons.
- To give priority in referral to training to qualified veterans and eligible persons.
- To give preferential treatment to special disabled veterans, including referrals to employers who are federal contractors, and in the provision of all needed local office services.
- To provide information and effective referral assistance to veterans and eligible persons regarding needed benefits and services that may be obtained through other agencies and organizations.
